

Mr. Subesh Kumar Singh took oath as State Information Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh on 26th February 2019. He joined Indian Forest Service in 1981. In the year 1984 he joined Indian Police Service.

In the state of Uttar Pradesh he served as Superintendent /Senior Superintendent of Police in districts like Pithoragarh, Mau, Jaunpur, Dehradun, Faizabad, Gorakhpur, Meerut, Allahabad, Farrukhabad, Lucknow and Agra. He was posted as Range DIG/IG in Saharanpur, Allahabad and Lucknow. He also served as IG STF UP. As ADG police he was posted as ADG Law and order, ADG STF, ADG ATS, ADG Karmik and ADG Training. On promotion he was posted as Director General, Economic Offense Wing.

On deputation to Government of India he worked in Indo Tibet Border Police as DIG, Garhwal (Indo-China Border). Subsequently on his promotion to IG he moved to CRPF as IG Srinagar and later as IG, personnel, CRPF Headquarters. In Srinagar, he was intensely engaged in anti-terrorist operations. President awarded him police medal for gallantry on two occasions for liquidating foreign terrorists in two different operations in Srinagar city. Besides, he was also awarded Special Duty Medals, Internal Security Medal, President's Police Medal for Long and meritorious Service and President's medal for distinguished services.

He has undergone various professional courses at Mount Abu, National Police Academy, Hyderabad, Crisis Management Course at Washington DC and London Business School, UK.
